

Battery Power Saving Tip

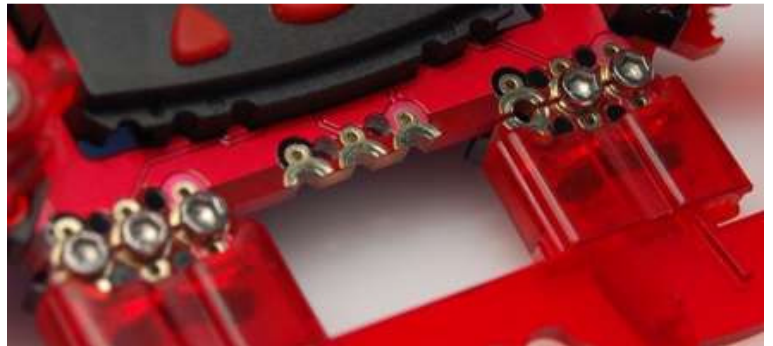
Even when the Ai2 is turned off it still uses a tiny amount of battery power, so it's a good idea to remove the batteries if you're not going to be using it for a while. This will stop the batteries from going flat.

The following modification makes it much easier to remove the battery box.

Step 1> Remove the line tracker module and skid.



Step 2> Remove the inside screw from the left bumper.



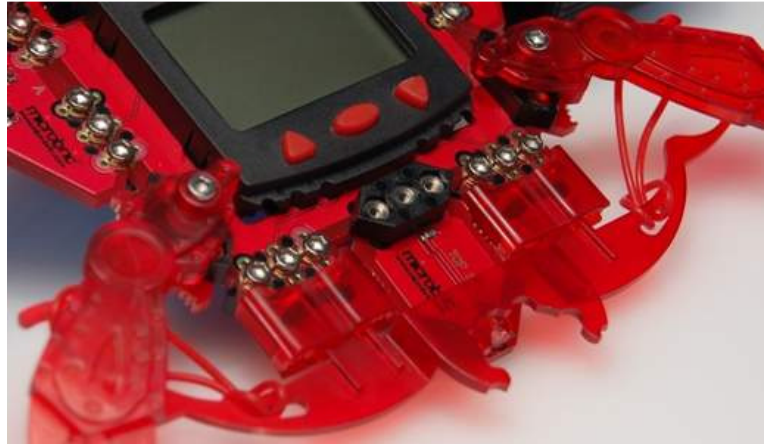
Step 3> Remove the inside nut from the left bumper and insert the spacer in its place.



Step 4> Push the skid on to the spacer.



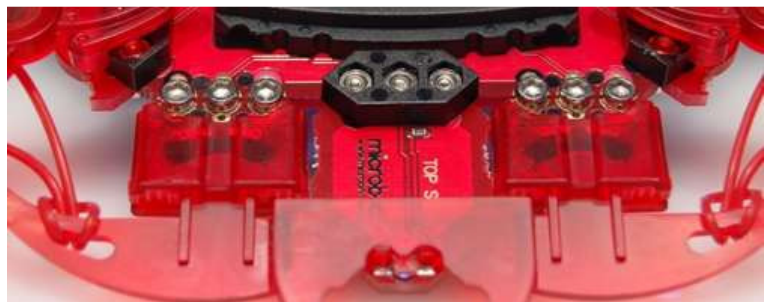
Step 5> Attach the line tracker module, but this time put the bric on top as shown - Remember to put the nut into the centre hole of the line tracker's bric!



Step 6> Insert and tighten the 3 screws that hold the line tracker on and the one screw on the bumper.



The front of your Ai2 should now look like this:



You can now easily remove the battery holder without having to remove the line tracker module.
